Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application dated 11.12.2012 and subsequent inspection of the school, I am directed to convey sanction for provisional affiliation to the above said school for Senior School Certificate Examination for a period of three years w.e.f. 1.4.2014 to 31.3.2017 in the following subjects:-

- (a) Languages:- Hindi Core, Hindi Elective, English Core, English Elective, Sanskrit.
- (b) Elective Subjects: History, Political Science, Geography, Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, Physical Education, Multimedia and Web Technology, Computer Science, Information Practices, Painting (Fine Arts), Music (Vocal & Instrumental), Home Science, Psychology, Entrepreneurship.

The sanction is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions in addition to the general conditions intimated at the time of grant of provisional affiliation for secondary classes:

1. "The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Senior School Certificate Examination and changes made therein from time to time."
2. The school will implement Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) as per the schemes of the Board upto Classes X.
3. As per the newly implemented CCE scheme vide Circular No. 39/20-09-2009 dated 20.09.2009, the students of class X will appear in the Summative Assessment-II (SA-II) conducted at the school level only. However, those students of class X, who opt to move out of CBSE system in Class XI to any other Board, will exercise the option to appear in the SA-II conducted at the Board level. Both the students will get the same certificate issued by the Board at the end of class X.
4. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State Govt./UT.
5. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.
6. The school will provide additional suitable facilities for classes XI and XII, as per requirements laid down in the rules.
7. It will increase the number of books in the Library and equipments in the Laboratories/Workshops with adequate games facilities etc. in consonance with the requirements of the Board for Classes XI & XII.

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It will appoint only qualified staff to teach Classes XI & XII as per requirements laid down by the Board.

9. It will provide facilities for adequate co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for the wholesome development of the students.
10. It will abide itself by the Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board and other rules and regulations prescribed by the Board from time to time.
11. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under from Pre-Primary to Class XII :-

12. School will provide physical facilities as per norms of the Board. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection are as given under:-

13. The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting, Drinking water, Sanitation, Transportation, etc.
14. The school will apply for further Extension of Provisional Affiliation on the prescribed form together with the prescribed fee of **Rs. 25,000/-** and other essential documents in the preceding year before the expiry of the date of provisional affiliation failing which penalty @ Rs. 10,000/- per month will be charged for late execution of application.
15. The school will open CBSE pattern classes XI w.e.f. 1.4.2014. Accordingly, 1st Batch of class XII of the school will be appearing at the CBSE Examination to be held in 2016.
16. Other conditions are as per Annexure 'A' enclosed.
17. Special conditions to be complied within three months:-

- i) Every School should organize at least one week training programme for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Govt. or by any agency identified by the Board.
- ii) Every institute will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students.
- iii) The Staff statement submitted by the school does not indicate the date of birth, experience, etc. of the teachers.
- iv) The non-proprietary character affidavit submitted by the school has not been sworn before 1st class Magistrate and therefore, the said affidavit may be submitted duly sworn in before 1st class Magistrate.

- v) Last three years copy of Income & Expenditure and Balance sheets duly audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant.
- vi) The school is required to submit certificate from the Banker regarding disbursement of salary through Bank advice by single cheque.
- vii) The school is required to pay prescribed pay scales along with DA and other admissible allowances to the staff at least at par with the State Govt. pay scales.
